Remembering CARTA by Yevgeny Yevtushenkoko



Great Russian poet, Yevgeniy Yevtushenko, was CARTA's Honorary member and a loyal friend of our Association. He recited his poetry at four CARTA Conferences and supported CARTA in its activities. Below is a part of the letter Yevgeniy Yevtushenko wrote for CARTA's 10th anniversary:

"Дорогие друзья, коллеги, из объединяющей нас всех нашей дорогой Днерожденицы CARTы, которой сейчас исполняется 10 лет! Но она весьма подающая надежды девочка, умненькая, благоразумненькая, даже читает книжки сверх школьной программы, а если открывает компьютер, то вовсе не для того, чтобы заниматься самурайскими играми, а находит ответы на самые главные вопросы.

Она, наша CARTA - это общая фотографическая карта наших фотографических душ не потерявших веру в смысл нашей профессии объединенных благородной задачей, чтобы наши ученики полюбили русский язык, литературы и не позволили бы чтобы в будущем повторилась бы опять холодная война между двумя такими еликими странами, как США и Россия. CARTA не занимается политикой. Но она может воспитать политиков будущего, которые будут понимать, что нация Генри Торо, Уолта Уитмана, Марка Твена, Фолкнера, Роберта Фроста, Хемингуза может дружить со страной Пушкина, Толстого, Чехова, Пастернака, Анны Ахматовой.

CARTA Members' News and Accomplishments

Amanbayeva, Sabina received 2023 STARTALK grant to host an in-person Russian immersion camp at Oklahoma City University, July 9-30, 2023, with a pre-camp online program, Feb.-May 2023, and a post-camp online program, Aug.-Dec. 2023. The camp is intended for 42 students in grades 9-14. She is co-editing an essay collection entitled "Transcultural Influences in Soviet and Post-Soviet Animation" (to be published in winter 2024).

Harris, Adrienne presented papers at the American Historical Association and at CARTA, but her biggest achievement was the birth of her third child, Jelena Lucija Jug. Adrienne, her husband Steven Jug, and children Anastasia and George welcomed Jelena November 17, 2022.



Liro, Joe, Emeritus Professor and himself a 1964 graduate of the USAF Academy, has visited with Professor Olga Scarborough's Russian classes at the Academy. Combined, their experience spans some sixty years.

Long, Michael was appointed to the inaugural three-member Editorial Board of the Association of Language Departments (ALD) Bulletin. Long is co-editing a volume of essays titled Speaking for Truth: Reflections on the Life and Legacy of Michael Bourdeaux and the Keston Archive. Freedom of Conscience in (Post-) Soviet Space and received a preliminary contract from Cornell University Press. He will conduct a 3week research trip to Georgia in June 2023. **Scarborough, Olga** presented her research on "Examining Student Motivation for Learning the Russian Language" at the 2022 AATSEEL Conference in Philadelphia, PA in February 2022. She also made a presentation based on her paper entitled "Miraculous Return of a Hungarian POW" at the virtual ASEEES Convention in October 2022.

Sukholutskaya, Mara made several presentations on history of Russia and Ukraine at the University, OFLTA Conference, Ada Public Libraries, March -November, 2022. She also presented a workshop on Russian Folkloric Art for the Startalk Program, Oklahoma City University, July 2022, and she presented a paper, "Кинофрагменты на занятиях по русскому языку в вузах США", Conference on the Potential of Art in Teaching; 2022.

Turner, Al has been busy adjusting to a move to Colorado, reworking a documentary on the influence of popular music on the persistence of Christianity in the United States, another look at vigilantism and a poetry collection. His documentary, *Dust to Eat*, premiered on Oklahoma Educational Television in February, with additional showings through the year and is also being used in Oklahoma public schools.


